Evaluation

Klas has managed a range of evaluations and often advises about data management and analysis for large evaluations.

- Evaluation of the *Sober Driver Program*, an educational and therapeutic intervention to reduce drink driving recidivism. Klas managed the data analysis for this major state-wide evaluation which included an experimental study design, and data from the Roads and Traffic Authority, NSW Department of Corrective Services and the Bureau of Crime Statistics and Research. Klas has subsequently undertaken follow-up recidivism analyses by matching program data with Bureau of Crime Statistics data (NSW Department of Corrective Services, 2006).
