STRATEGIC MONITORING AND EVALUATION

Andrew's experience across sectors means he helps clients 'join the dots' in unexpected ways. He listens deeply to his clients to understand the nature of their problem and policy context, bringing his grounding in theory for the practice of evaluation to generate evidence and insight.

ADVANCING THE FIELD OF EVALUATION

The common thread through Andrew's career has been a strategic and continuous process of questioning, acting and reflecting that is necessary when dealing with the uncertainty of public policy endeavours. Andrew developed a system called Program Design Logic for making sense of programs 'on paper' and 'in reality'. This tool builds on first generation program logic pioneered by ARTD in the early 1990s. It is designed as much for policy and program design as it is for evaluation.
