### DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

- » **Bin Trim Round 4 Evaluation and Review** (NSW Environment Protection Authority, 2021): Conducting and analysing interviews with assessors and grantees funded by EPA to support NSW businesses to recycle more and reduce waste to landfill.

### RESEARCH AND REVIEW

- » **Complaint Management System Review** (QLD Crime and Corruption Commission, 2021): Conducting an extensive literature review surrounding the barriers that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people experience in accessing complaints systems, and opportunities to increase more meaningful engagement to achieve better outcomes for complainants.
- » **Evaluation of the Co-Location Pilot** (Attorney-Generals Department, 2021): Reviewing and analysing detailed and legalistic milestone reports provided by state and territory child protection and policing officials in family law courts across Australia participating in the Pilot.
- » **Tirkandi Inaburra Outcomes Tracking Support** (Tirkandi Inaburra Cultural and Development Centre, 2021): Reviewing academic and grey literature around behaviour management with Aboriginal young people and supporting the development of a practice framework and guide to support Tirkandi staff.

- » **NSW Department of Communities and Justice and Abcare Memorandum of Understanding** (NSW DCJ, Abcare, 2021): Developing and drafting a MOU detailing an ongoing working relationship to implement the principles in the Aboriginal Case Management Policy 2018 for strengthening Aboriginal families and delivering outcomes for Aboriginal children and young people.
- » **Illawarra Aboriginal Corporation Going Home, Staying Home** (IAC, 2021): Drafting service provision guidelines outlining core policies and procedures of the housing program, and supporting IAC staff to provide consistent work practices as a specialist
