HEALTH

Kerry has worked on health projects across a range of topic areas, from illicit drugs to support programs for vulnerable people, and in a range of settings, including hospitals and community settings. Recent projects include the evaluation of the **Visit Program** for Open Support; research to inform the development of **Clinical Practice Guidelines for the physiotherapy management of people with Spinal Cord Injuries**; **NSW Service Plan for People with Eating Disorders**; and the evaluation of the **NSW Crystalline Methamphetamine Community Education Program**.

DISABILITY

Kerry has worked with a range of people in disability sector projects, including people with an intellectual disability and those with a physical disability, and their carers, as well as service managers and staff. She is experienced in using accessible communication tools, such as Easy Read. Recent projects include the evaluation of the **Younger Onset Dementia Advisor Program**; and evaluations of two consumer education programs for the Department of Fair Trading – **Talkin' Together** and the **Consumer Awareness Protection Initiative**.

EDUCATION

Kerry has worked extensively with schools, both primary and secondary, interviewing students, school staff and parents. Kerry has an intimate understanding of the sensitivities of working within the education sector. Projects include research to inform the development of a new **National Evidence Institute**; the evaluation of **Youth Frontiers**, a youth mentoring program; and the review of **Special Religious Education and Special Education in Ethics**.

JUSTICE
