STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT, DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

- » **Mobile Preschools Proposed New Funding Model** (NSW Department of Community and Justice, 2019 - ongoing): This is a process and outcomes evaluations of the six Service Improvement Initiatives which are a part of the reform. Paula is project managing a longitudinal case-study sub-project, seeking to develop in depth case studies to assist the Department to better understand how the reforms work in the lives of their clients.
- » **Disability Inclusion Plan** (NSW Public Service Commission, 2021): Organised and coordinated workshops with 25 people with disability in NSW. Undertook thematic analysis using a Qualitative Comparative Analysis (QCA) approach to understand correlation factors for the Public Service Commission Disability Inclusion Project.
- » **Fair Work Commission National Wage Assessment Structure Trial** (Department of Social Services, 2020-21): Transcribed, coded and analysed a large qualitative data set using the NVivo software as part of the evaluation of a new wage assessment structure for supported employees nationally.
- » **Entrepreneurship Facilitation Evaluation** (Department of Education, Skills, and Employment, 2021): Coded and thematically analysed interviews using the NVivo software to understand the impact of the entrepreneurship facilitation program across Australia.
- » **Evaluation of the Co-location Pilot** (Attorney-Generals Department, 2021): Comparatively analysed open-text survey data to provide the Attorney-Generals Department with evidence that will assist the development of the co-location model.

RESEARCH AND REVIEW

- » **Disability Inclusion Plan** (NSW Public Service Commission, 2021): Completed a targeted literature scan of peer reviewed and grey literature surrounding the barriers and enablers for people with disability to disclose their disability at work.
- » **Fire Management Evaluation** (National Parks Wildlife Service, 2021-ongoing): Completed a document review and analysis to assess whether the NPWS had met their action plan criteria.
- » **Recovery at Work Evaluation** (SIRA, 2021-ongoing): Catalogued and synthesised early scoping documents to provide greater understanding of the Recovery at Work program.
