- » **The NSW K-2 Curriculum Reform Qualitative Evaluation** (NSW Department of Education, 2023-2024): Managing the qualitative evaluation of the K-2 Curriculum Reform as it is being rolled out at schools across the state. The project includes coordinating, conducting, and analysing several interviews with stakeholders, and providing findings to the department per term.

Conducted interviews and collated all data to synthesis findings for client and sector facing reports.
